1. Eiffel Tower, it's a touristic iconic iron tower in France;
2. Great Wall of China, massive ancient fortification in China, build to protect the borders from invaders;
3. Taj Mahal, magnificent white marble mausoleum in India;
4. Stonehenge, prehistoric monument in England;
5. Moai, enigmatic giant stone statues on Easter Island, Chile;
6. Colosseum, ancient amphitheater in Roma, famous for gladiators contests;
7. Buckingham Palace, official residence of the British monarch in London;
8. Crist the Redeemer, iconic statue of Jesus Christ in Rio de Janeiro, Brasil, standing atop the Corcovado mountain, symbolizing peace and Christianity;
9. Mount Fuji, Japan's highest peak and an active stratovolcano, revered as a sacred symbol and attracting climbers and tourists from around the world;
10. Egypt's Pyramids, ancient monumental structures located in Egypt, build as tombs for pharaohs;
11. Mount Kilimanjaro, Africa's tallest mountain, located in Tanzania, known for its snow-capped summit and diverse ecosystems;
12. Sydney Opera House, architectural masterpiece in Sydney Harbor, Australia, featuring distinctive sail-like structures;
13. Leaning Tower of Pisa, freestanding bell tower in Pisa, Italy, renowned for its unintended tilt caused by unstable ground;
14. Big Ben, iconic clock tower part of the Palace of Westminster in London, recognized as a symbol of the city and British culture;
15. Kukulcan, it's a step pyramid located in Chichen Itza, Mexico, build by the Maya civilization and used for astronomical purposes and rituals.
